TOURNAMENT PROGRAMME:

- o 8.30am Senior Tournament commences 14yrs+ (Kata events first)
- o 1pm Junior Tournament commences 6-13yrs (Kata events first)

NOTE: It is the player's responsibility to listen for events being called and to report to the Marshall on time. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

The Tournament Organiser must receive all entry forms by *15th May 2010*, accompanied by entry fees and correct information or make payment into the Karate Auckland Westpac account 03 0123 0328727.

Entry forms received without payment or not payment showing in the Auckland account will not be accepted.

No late entries will be accepted

The following dress and safety equipment code will apply:

- All competitors must wear KNZ approved Hand mitts, Red and Blue
- All competitors must wear mouthguards
- All competitors must wear a clean white Gi in good condition
- All male competitors (particularly seniors) should wear groin protectors
- All female competitors (particularly seniors) are encouraged to wear chest protectors
- All competitors are **must** wear shin and Instep protectors (only one colour is acceptable)
- 6-11yrs **may** wear white foam or coloured shin and instep protectors

NOTE: *If there are insufficient entries in a particular division then divisions may be combined or not held.*

COMPETITION RULES

As per current WKF Rules with the following modifications

KUMITE RULES TO APPLY TO ALL KARATE NEW ZEALAND (UNZKO) SANCTIONED TOURNAMENTS:

On scoring/contact:

1. 6-13yrs - techniques to the head can score but absolutely **NO** contact will be allowed. Any contact at all, (unless by Mubobi) including skin touch, will be penalised.
2. Ages 6-9yrs the mat size for this age group **will** be reduced to 6 Metres Square. First to 8 points wins.
3. Cadet (14/15) junior (16/17) and seniors (18yrs+) – as per WKF rulebook.

Bout duration:

6yrs to 9yrs	Bout duration 1.5 minutes with	30 second match extension
10yrs to 15yrs	Bout duration 2 minutes with	1 minute match extension
16 & 17 yrs as per WKF rules	Bout duration 2 minutes with	1 minute match extension
18 yrs to 20 yrs as per WKF rules	Bout duration as per WKF	2min-Female, 3min Male 1 min match extension
18 yrs and over as per WKF rules	Bout duration as per WKF	2min- Female, 3min Male 1 min match extension

KATA TO BE JUDGED AS FOLLOWS:

The judging of all Kata competition will follow the WKF flag system.

10 - 7kyu Divisions

All Ages Kata may be repeated every round; competition is restricted to “development” kata

6 - 4 kyu Divisions

6/7yrs Kata may be repeated but not in consecutive rounds; competition is restricted to “development” kata

8/9yrs Kata may be repeated but not in consecutive rounds; competition is restricted to “development” kata

10yrs+ Kata divisions are OPEN; this means that both “Premier” and “Development” may be performed

10/11yrs Kata may be repeated but not in consecutive rounds; Free kata

12/13yrs Kata may not be repeated; Free kata

14yrs+ Kata may not be repeated; Free kata,

KUMITE and KATA DIVISIONS:

Divisions with three competitors will be run *round robin* with the placing's decided on the number of wins achieved. If each competitor has one win each then placing's will be decided on total points scored.

Divisions with four competitors will have a match between the two competitors who have not won a match to decide on one third place.

Divisions with five to eight competitors will follow the *repechage* system to decide on one third-place

Divisions with nine or more competitors will use *repechage* to decide the third-equal placing's.

For Karate, *repechage* involves the competitors who were beaten by a finalists playing-off to decide the third-equal placing's.

This means that all medal winners, except possibly for third-place in a *round-robin* division, will have won at least one match.

Coaches

As per WKF rules, follow the code of behaviour and the *dress code*. Only one coach on the mat at a time, only official coaches on the mat and in the warm up area. (no tracksuit – no sitting in the corner)
